

Maths Challenge

There is a maths challenge for your child to complete every fortnight. Children **do not need to write anything down in their book**. All of these number facts will help them in maths lessons. Remember if the challenge is too hard or too easy then change the numbers. Your child can always come back to a challenge that they need some extra help with. Your child will have a **short test in Friday's maths lesson** to see how well they have completed the challenge. Support will then be given during future lessons. Please ask you child's teacher if you have any questions.

Date of assessment:	Maths Challenge	Example test questions	Comment/ signature by adult
20 th January	This weeks' maths challenge is to count in fives, up to 50. Think about how the numbers end in a zero or a five. You could discuss how we could recognise other numbers beyond 50 (children do not need to write these down) 0, 5, 10, 15 etc.	Can you count in fives to 50?	
3 rd February	This weeks' maths challenge is to count in tens, up to 100. Think about how the numbers end in a zero. You could discuss how we could recognise other numbers beyond 100 (children do not need to write these down) 0, 10, 20, 30 etc.	Can you count in tens to 100?	

After children have shared their results, maths challenge books should be bought back into school and kept in their trays.

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
